1 Track API Retirement

We advise integrators currently using *Track* to transition to *TrackV2* at your earliest convenience in preparation for the retirement of the *Track* API on **February 24, 2017**. You may use your current production UserID and the following URL scheme, host and path to access *TrackV2*:

If you are using software for your tracking purchased from a certified USPS software vendor, please email us the software name at webtools@usps.com. We will work with the vendor to insure they are compliant before the conversion deadline.

1.1 Request XML considerations

All request tags that exist in *Track* still exist in the same order in *TrackV2*. The optional *TrackV2* "Track Fields" request type has a number of new optional tags that can be used to receive some new information as well as to receive the same tracking status information in a different format. Please reference the full *Tracking and Delivery Information* technical guide at <https://www.usps.com/business/web-tools-apis/documentation-updates.htm>.

The following section demonstrates the changes that need to be made for a current, functioning *Track* request to work for *TrackV2*. All sections that must be changed or verified for compliance with *TrackV2* requirements are highlighted. Please take note of the following:

- You must replace the API=Track with API=TrackV2

Please note that you must place your valid USERID into the request.
